The Cadel Evans Great Ocean Road Race is an initiative of the Victorian Government, created by Visit Victoria, and a pillar of Australia's major events calendar.

SURF COAST CLASSIC TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT INFORMATION

- » An additional Cadel Evans Great Ocean Road Race event is coming to the Surf Coast and The Otways regions on Thursday 25 January 2024.
- » The Surf Coast Classic is a point to point course from Lorne to Torquay via inland route (see map on reverse for details).
- » Victoria Police will facilitate a rolling road closure for this race, which reduces the impact of the event. Vehicles will not be able to travel on or cross the route while the rolling road closure passes through. Delays of 15–20 minutes are expected.
- » Disruption to traffic will be minimal and the Great Ocean Road will remain open after a brief 15 min hold for race start between the Deans Marsh-Lorne Road roundabout and the Lorne Visitor Information Centre.
- » The Race route will take in the towns of Deans Marsh, Barwon Downs, Forrest, Yeodene, Whoorel, Bamba, Modewarre, Bells Beach and Jan Juc.
- » The rolling road closure will be supported by some fixed road closures to assist in keeping the course roads free of traffic when the race is coming through. All major intersections including the Great Ocean Road will remain open, except when the race passes by.
- » The Deans Marsh-Lorne Rd will be closed to -
Lorne bound traffic between 10.30 am and 11.45 am - and
Deans Marsh bound traffic between 10.45 am and 11.15 am.

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- » The Great Ocean Road will remain open at all times during the Surf Coast Classic to ensure north/south traffic movements through the Surf Coast and Colac regions are maintained.
- » Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during the event via existing footpaths. Where roads are closed for short periods, access across roads will be via marshalled course crossing points.
- » It is advised to allow extra travel time on event days in case you experience short delays whilst travelling near the course.
- » If you are travelling along a course road as a rolling road closure comes through, you will be stopped by the lead police vehicle and asked to park in a safe area on the side of the road.
- » Once the race has passed the rear police car will inform you that it is safe for you to move off.
- » There will be restricted parking on any road which the course travels along. To assist, please ensure you park your car either on a driveway if available or on a side street off the course.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

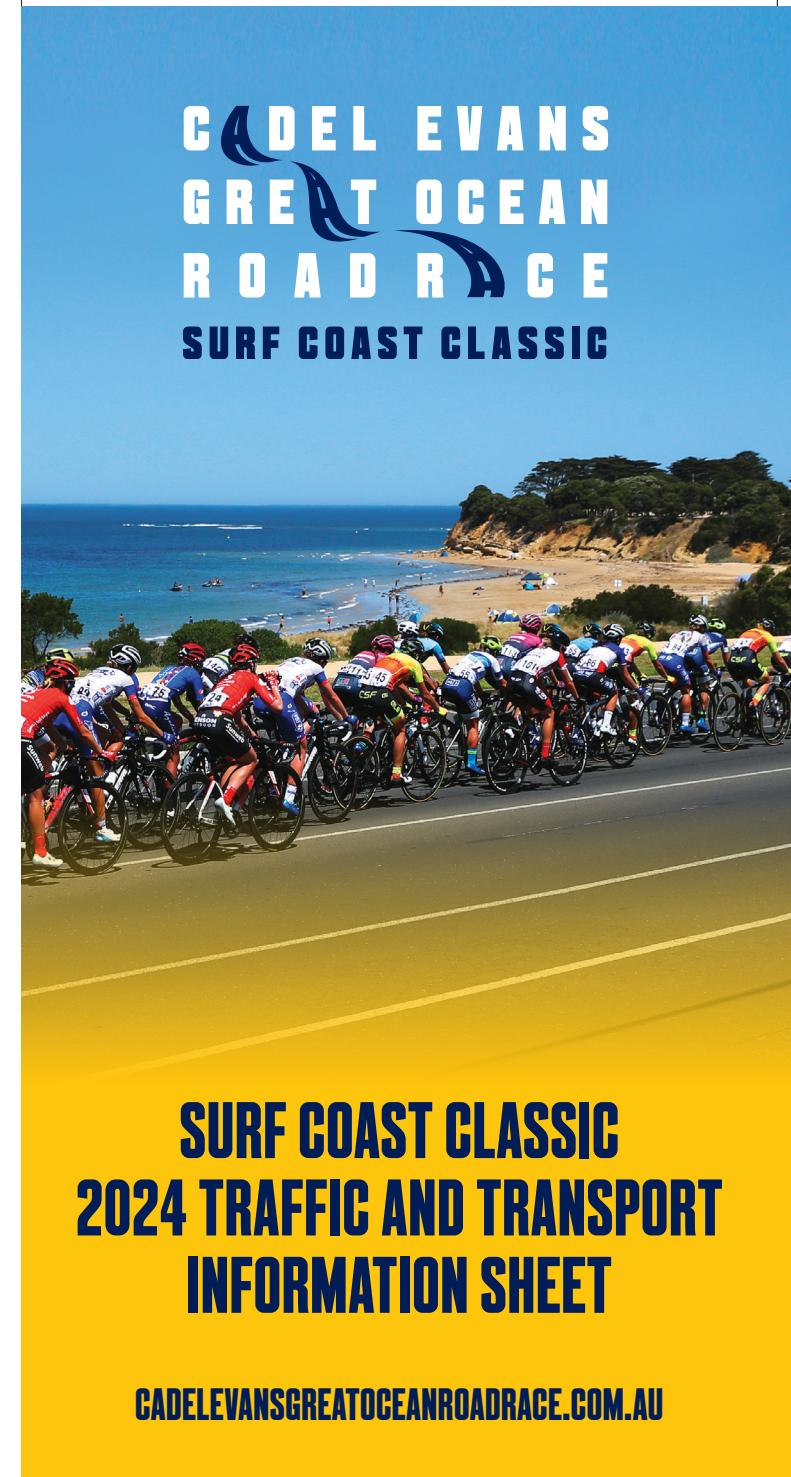

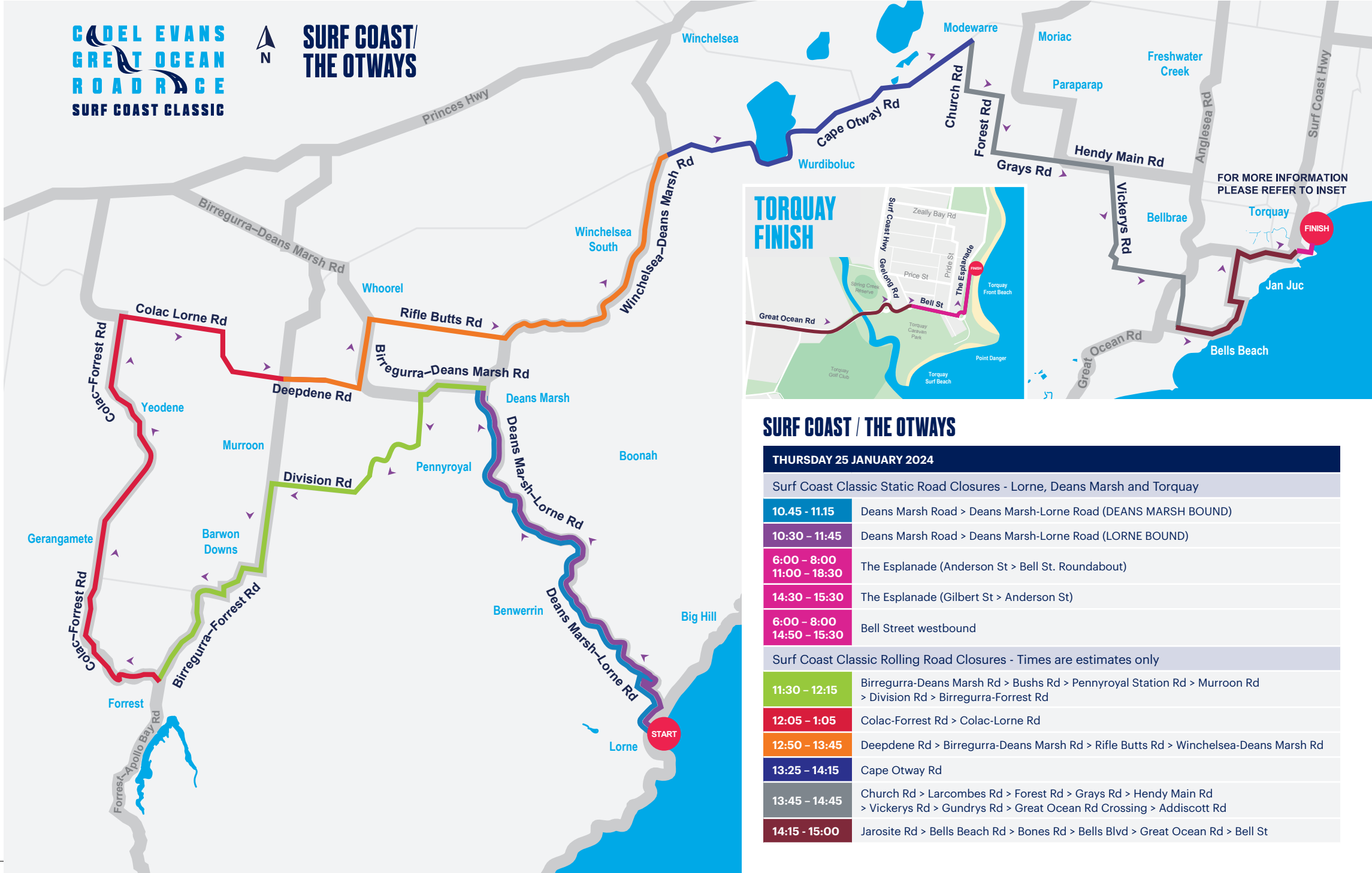
